CIRCULAR

Sub:- KUHS-Dean SA – Covid 19 – Updated guidelines of the University Covid Advisory Committee – Issued for compliance by all stake holders – Reg.

Ref:- 1. Previous updated guidelines issued on 15.01.2022

As the Covid situation in the state has improved significantly, the committee has recommended further relaxation of many protocols followed by the institutions during the preceding pandemic period as detailed below:-

1. Testing for Covid 19 is not necessary for entry into colleges or hostels or before theory or practical examinations.
2. However, staff and students having any symptoms suggestive of Covid 19 are advised to undergo voluntary self-quarantine for 7 days for the sake of containing any possible future outbreak. They need not undergo compulsory Covid testing during or after quarantine but may end self-quarantine if result of RTPCR test done after the onset of such symptoms is negative.
3. Covid positive persons need not test again after the completion of their prescribed quarantine period.
4. All curricular and extracurricular programs like graduation ceremonies, arts and sports events and tours may be conducted by complying with the prevailing Govt. protocols.
5. Staff and students shall continue the use of masks and hand hygiene measures. Safe distance and good ventilation shall be ensured in all indoor activities. Sharing of food, drinks and gadgets shall be discouraged. Respiratory etiquette shall be practiced meticulously.
6. Other previous restrictions or special considerations related to Covid 19 are withdrawn.
