



ANNUAL REPORT: June 2021- August 2022

Pushpagiri College of Dental Sciences started in the year 2006 with an annual intake of 50 students. The Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, through the Dental Council of India, recognized this institution. The College is affiliated to the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala and New Batches to Kerala University of Health Sciences, KUHS. The first batch of Pushpagiri College of Dental Sciences secured a 100% pass result in the Final BDS examination conducted by Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Pushpagiri College of Dental Sciences was the only dental college to achieve this feat among other dental colleges affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Ms Varsha Jeyaprakash secured the first rank in the Final BDS examination 2011 conducted by Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Pushpagiri College of Dental Sciences stood first among the 24 dental colleges affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur in the first BDS examination held in August 2014. Ms Jasmin Mary George (2013 batch) secured the 1st Rank in the I BDS Examination (August 2014) conducted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. The first batch of MDS students secured 100% result in the examination conducted in August 2016. Dr. Karun Koshy Cherian secured the Second rank in the Final MDS examination (Orthodontics) conducted by Kerala University of Health Sciences in June 2017. Dr Mekha Grace Varghese secured the First rank in the Final MDS (Periodontics) examination June 2021.

Pushpagiri College of Dental Sciences is housed in the second campus of Pushpagiri Medical Society, The Pushpagiri Medicity; which is just 3 kilometers away from Tiruvalla town and is beside the state highway (S.HI) (previously Main Central Road). The International airports Thiruvananthapuram and Cochin are 128km and 112km away in the south and north directions

respectively. The coastal belt of the country is 25 km away in the west direction and the Western Ghats lies 70 km east of the town. Geographically, the town lies at 9.6° longitude and 76.5° The vast paddy fields form the south and west boundaries of the college campus. The southwestern breeze ever passing through the paddy fields and patting the treetops provides a cool climate in this scenic location, which is quite distant from the hustle and bustle of the town.
