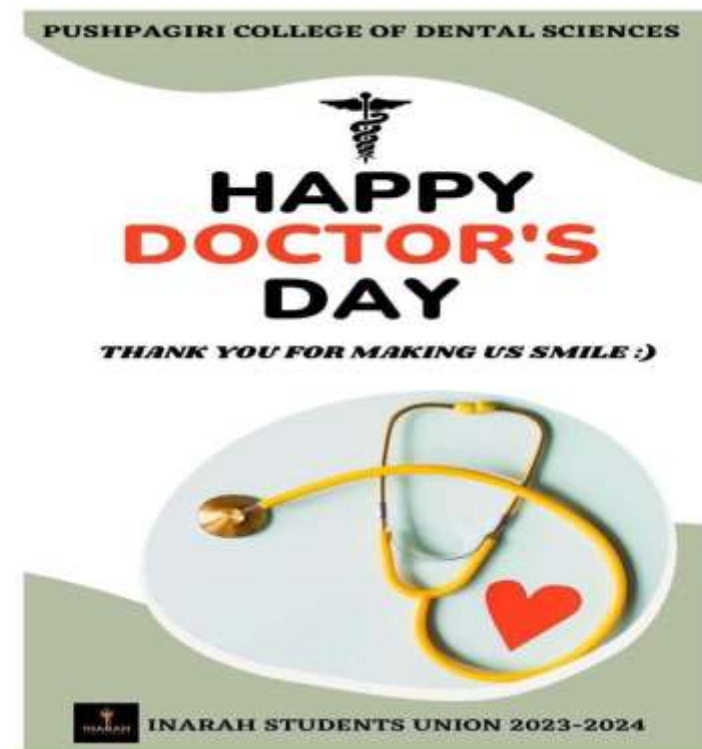


## CARING HANDS, HEALING HEARTS: DOCTORS' DAY CELEBRATION.

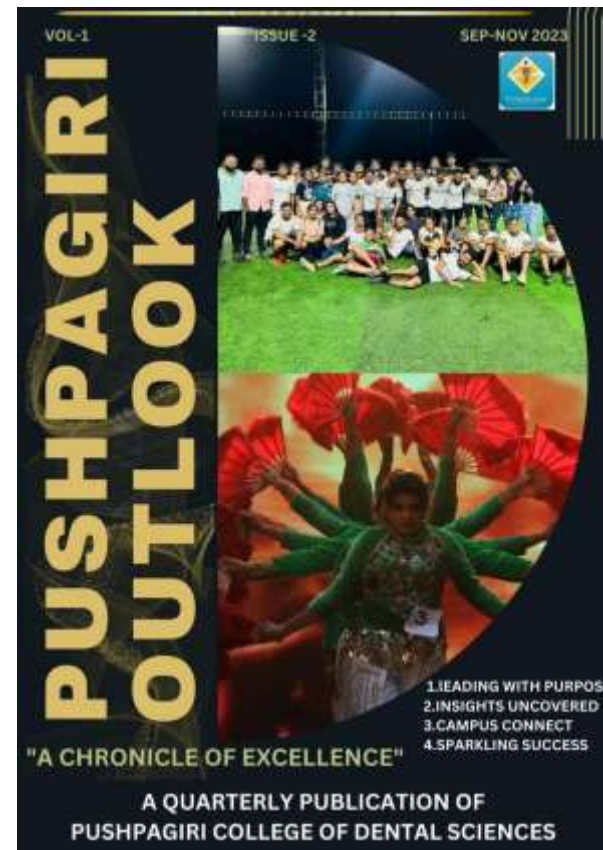
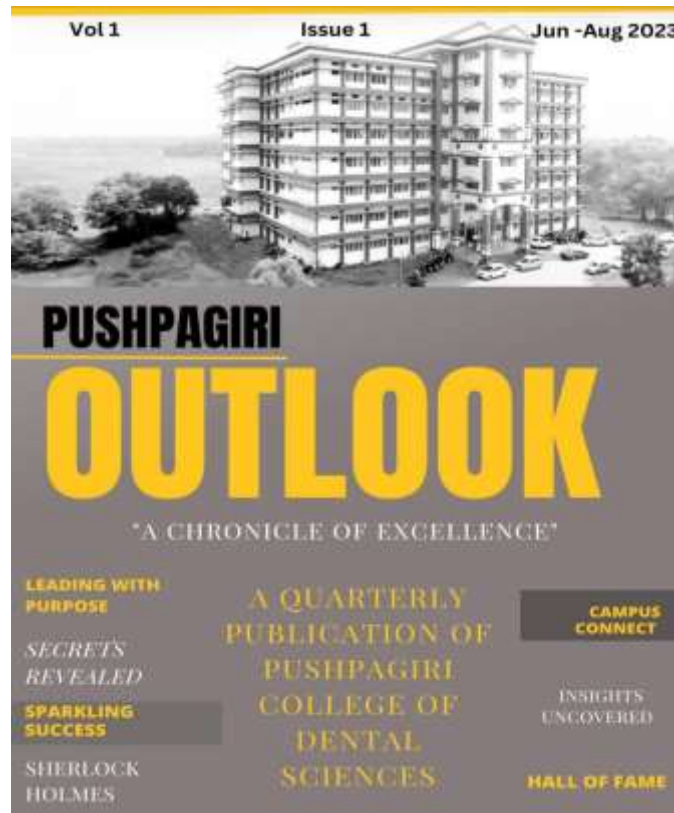

## PUSHPAGIRI OUTLOOK

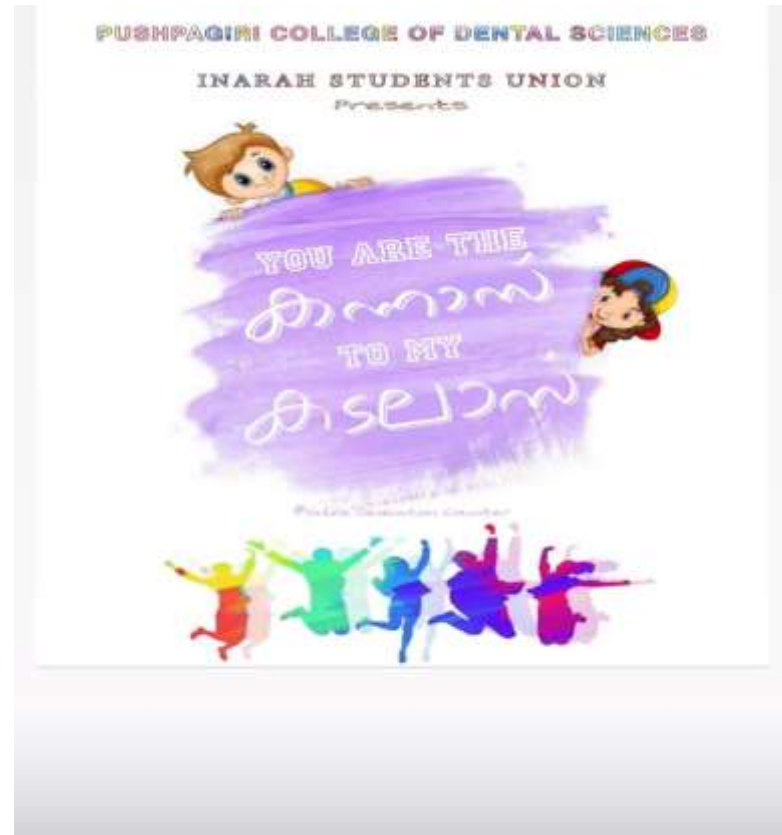
